A tax rate of \$0.709698 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Crane County.

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2024 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Crane County from the same properties in both the 2023 tax year and the 2024 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Crane County may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Crane County is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2024 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 24, 2024 AT 9:30 AM AT Commissioner's Courtroom, 201 W 6th, Crane.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Crane County is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Commissioner's Court of Crane County at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.
