I. General Requirements:

Crane County is interested in obtaining bids for Paving in Crane County, Texas. No money shall be paid to the contractor until completion and acceptance of the work by Crane County Commissioners Court.

II. Product Information:

Complete product information and descriptive literature shall be submitted with the bid. Information submitted shall be sufficiently detailed to substantiate that products offered meet or exceed the specifications. Vendor is hereby put on notice that all information submitted according to this requirement will be incorporated by reference in the contract document arising out of vendor's response; and may be subject to express contract warranties.

III. Proposal Cost Errors:

Vendors are expected to thoroughly examine the specifications and all instructions. Preparation of cost extensions shall be at the vendor's risk. In the event of a vendor error in any cost extension, the vendor's unit price shall prevail.

IV. Proposal Closing Date:

Bids must be received by Crane County no later than **April 25th, 2022, by 4:00 p.m.** Requests for extensions of the closing date or time will not be granted. Bids arriving late or unsealed will not be considered. Vendors should allow sufficient mailing time to insure the timely receipt of Bid. All Bids must be submitted as originals. **NO FAX COPIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

1. Asphalt shall not be applied when the weather conditions are not favorable.
2. No asphalt will be applied when the atmospheric temperature is less than 60 degrees F and falling.
3. Contractor shall maintain and operate, at least, two pneumatic rollers on the project at all times, and a steel wheel where needed.
4. The Contractor shall have a water truck on the project at all times of sufficient size and with pumping capacity to wet the aggregate stockpiles as directed. The water truck shall be subject to the approval of the Road Superintendent.
5. There will be storage and heating capability provided on the project at all times by the contractor and shall be subject to the approval of the Road Superintendent.
6. All AC10 asphalt will be distributed at 350 degrees F.
7. Care shall be taken by the contractor not to cover manholes and valve boxes with asphalt during all construction operations.
8. The County will be responsible for blading grass and patching potholes where necessary prior to paving.
9. All paving must be completed by **September 30th, 2022**. There will be no exceptions.
10. Bids shall include hauling, spreading, rolling, brooming, cleaning streets and gutters.
11. In awarding bids Crane County will consider past performance.
