Crane Memorial Hospital would like to provide the following information to our Crane County Residents. Crane Memorial Hospital implemented a no visitors plan on March 13, 2020 in regards to the mandates by Texas Department of State Health Services and the CDC due to the Coronavirus pandemic. With the first confirmed case of Covid-19 in Crane County we would like to reassure the public that there has NOT been a case of Covid-19 admitted to the hospital. The case in Crane County was managed at home. CMH would like to stress the importance that our community follows the guidelines that have been established by the CDC during this time. The rural health clinic continues to see patients. We ask that you call in and schedule an appointment. Please Do Not Panic. Follow the guidelines established by the CDC.

Current Precautions at Crane Memorial Hospital and Rural Health Clinic include:

- No Visitors at Hospital or with ER patients.
- No Walk- In Appointments at Rural Health Clinic, patients are scheduled to prevent clustering of patients in waiting room and decrease exposure to all infections.
- All Staff and Vendors will be screened at the Employee entrance prior to entering the building.
- Emergency Room visits – call ahead if possible 432-558-3555 x 135, use the emergency room entrance.
- Account payments can be made online or by phone.

If you are not sick please do not schedule an appointment to be seen at this time, if you need medication refills please call the clinic and the provider will discuss any needs you have at that time.
