**ORDER PROHIBITING CERTAIN FIREWORKS
IN UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF CRANE COUNTY, TEXAS**

WHEREAS, the Texas Forest Service has determined that drought conditions exist in Crane County; and


WHEREAS, on the 13th day of April 2021, the Commissioners Court of Crane County has determined that the normal danger of fire in the unincorporated areas of Crane County is greatly enhanced by the extremely dry conditions now existing;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Crane County adopts this Order prohibiting the sale or use of restricted fireworks in the unincorporated areas of Crane County.


- A. No person may sell, detonate, ignite, or in any way, use fireworks classified under 49C.F.R. part 173.100@ (10-1-86edition) as "skyrockets with sticks" and "missiles with fins" in any portion of the unincorporated area of Crane County.
- B. This Order does not prohibit:
1. common fireworks, small in size classified as Class C explosives;
 2. large fireworks devices designed primarily to produce visible or audible effects by combustion, deflagration, or detonation and classified as Class B explosive by the U.S. Dept of Transportation (TEX.OCC.CODE, Chapter 2154).
- C. A person commits an offense if the person knowingly or intentionally violates a prohibition established by this Order. An offense under this order is a Class C Misdemeanor.
- D. This order expires on the date the Texas Forest Service determines drought conditions no longer exist in the county or Insert date on or after December 20 and January 1 of the following year, whichever is earlier.
